

Preston & Wingham Primary Schools Federation - HOME/SCHOOL AGREEMENT

In order for our pupils to be given the best chance to achieve of their best during their time at Wingham/Preston Primary School, it is essential that the school, parents/carers and children work together to develop a mutually supportive relationship. In order for this to be achieved, it is essential that all parties sign up to, and abide by, this home-school agreement.

Agreement for Parents/Carers - I will strive to:

- Establish a professional relationship with the school approaching all members of staff with courtesy and respect.
- Ensure my child's attendance is at least 97% each academic year.
- Ensure my child arrives at school on time and is collected from school on time each day.
- Ensure my child wears the correct school uniform and PE kit.
- Support my child to take all the equipment they need to school each day.
- Support my child to ensure homework (including regular reading/reading tasks, word work/spellings and times tables practice) is completed carefully and is handed in on time
- Work with the school to ensure my child's behaviour enables my child, and their peers, to learn.
- Work with the school to address instances where my child does not abide by the school rules.
- Contact the school as soon as possible, by telephone or in writing, if my child is absent
- Inform the school immediately if there are any circumstances that may affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Attend parent consultations and any other meetings required.
- Engage with outside agencies when required.

Agreement For Pupils (Signed on entry to Year 3) - I will do my best to:

- Complete all activities and work to the best of my ability.
- Complete homework (including regular reading/reading tasks, word work/spellings and times tables practice) carefully and hand it in on time.
- Ensure that my behaviour allows me to learn and my classmates to learn.
- Listen to and act upon the instructions of all adults in school.
- Keep the school rules and behave well.
- Wear the correct school uniform and PE Kit.
- Bring all the equipment I need every day.
- Tell an adult straight away if I am worried about anything in school.
- Take good care of the school environment

Agreement For School - The school will strive to:

- Create a happy, caring and secure environment that achieves excellence in the provision of education for all our children.
- Establish a professional relationship with parents/carers.
- Offer a broad, balanced and enriched curriculum which meets the needs of all the children.
- Expect the best from all children in relation to their behaviour and attitudes to work.
- Employ the principles of equality of opportunity as detailed in the school's Single Equality Scheme.
- Track the progress of each child and discuss any concerns with parents.
- Provide two formal parental consultations each academic year and a written annual report of achievement.
- Set, mark and monitor home tasks regularly in keeping with the school's policy.
- Employ the support of outside agencies when required.
