- To explore the local environment and how community can be important to develop ideas

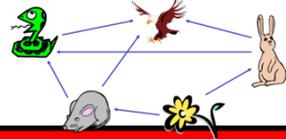

## Science

Scientific Enquiry:

- Plan different types of scientific enquiries to answer questions, including recognising and controlling variables where necessary
- Taking measurements, using a range of scientific equipment, with increasing accuracy and precision, taking repeat readings when appropriate
- Record data and results of increasing complexity using scientific diagrams and labels, classification keys, tables, scatter graphs, bar and line graphs
- Using test results to make predictions to set up further comparative and fair tests
- Animals including Humans- Consider how diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle affect the way the body functions



## Music

To play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing a musical instrument (ukulele)  
To appreciate and understand a wide range of high quality live and recorded music from different times



## Art

- Improve their mastery of art and design techniques to include lino printing using POP art as a stimulus
- Use a sketchbook to review and revisit ideas -Graffiti designs



## DT

- Select and use a range of tools and equipment
- Design a product that is fit for purpose (Lino cutting to link with art)
