## Statement of Intent for Art

### Intent

#### Why do we teach this?

The art curriculum is designed to engage and inspire all children. It provides opportunities for the children to develop their skills in drawing, painting, printing, textiles, 3D, collage and ICT so that they are able to create their own imaginative pieces of work. We teach the children about great artists and designers as well as other cultures. Children's learning to be clearly sequenced so that they are able to practise and experiment with skills and techniques used by other artists before planning and creating a final piece of work. Our children develop the skills to critique their own and others work in order to make good progress.

### Implementation

#### What do we teach and how?

Our progression of skills for art ensures that children build on previous learning in each area of art. Children study carefully selected artists that are relevant to each unit topic which allows them to have an appreciation of art history. They critique their own and others work by making kind, helpful and specific comments. These comments support and help children to continually improve their work.

### Impact

#### What will this look like?

The knowledge and skills that children acquire through the teaching of art demonstrates their confidence and enthusiasm. Children are able to apply what they have learnt in order to create a quality final piece of artwork. Children can make links with other subject e.g. transport, trains, Turner. Children can create artwork in the style of artists studied. Children can articulate techniques, style, medium and inspiration of chosen artists. The children demonstrate their knowledge and artist skills within the FLOURISH day.
