Art /DT and Music

As artists we will make observational drawings of our outside environment. We will look at Piet Mondrian's trees and Van Gough's sunflowers and use these paintings to inspire our own artwork. We will explore how Eric Carle uses collage to illustrate his books and make our own collage. In DT we will explore, design and make our own habitats for mini beasts.

In music we will explore how to use our voice and bodies to make sounds experimenting with tempo and dynamic when playing instruments and identifying sounds in the environment.

We will also be learning about the 4 different groups of musical instruments, following a beat, using untuned instruments and performing a practiced song to a small audience.

We will take part in a variety of outdoor games, develop our ball skills and undertake a range of athletic activities. We will manipulate, mould, weave and create using a range of objects to enhance our fine motor skills. We will continue to develop our understanding of how to lead a healthy lifestyle - make soup/salad.

Science, Geography, Computing, French

We will learn about growth and change. We will develop our understanding of the key features of the life cycle of plants and a variety of animals. We will plant a range of flowers and vegetables and care for them to gain knowledge about how they grow, develop and reproduce. We will continue to develop our understanding of the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around us. We will look at different types of weather and how the weather affects different plants and seeds from growing. We will continue to explore the natural environment around us, describing what we see, hear and feel whilst outside. We will further develop our understanding of the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things. We will learn that environments are different by exploring our village school environment and comparing this to a seaside town. We will look at and create simple sticky boards and photographic maps. In computing we will create photo stories and use editing tools to edit and enhance their photos.
