In our writing journeys we will study:

Geography-

As geographers we will continue our study on the UK recapping our knowledge. We will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key features including: beach, cliff, coast, sea, ocean, forest, hill, mountain, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather. We will focus on the weather and seasons with a focus on Autumn and Winter.

Computing :Beebots programming

We will explore how hardware works. We will use Bee-Bots to navigate an area and construct simple instructions.

PE- Multi-skills/ Yoga

In we will copy, explore basic movements with some control and coordination. We will demonstrate different body shapes and perform safely at different levels. We will link movements together to create a sequence.
In games we will develop our ball skills and perform a range of throws and develop our hand eye coordination. We will participate in simple games. We will apply and combine a variety of skills to a game situation.

DT- POP UP Books

As designers we will draw upon our own experience to help generate ideas and suggest ideas and explain what they are going to do. We will model our ideas in card and paper and develop our design applying ideas from research. We will with help measure, mark, cut out and shape the materials we use. We will evaluate our book and identify any possible changes needed.
